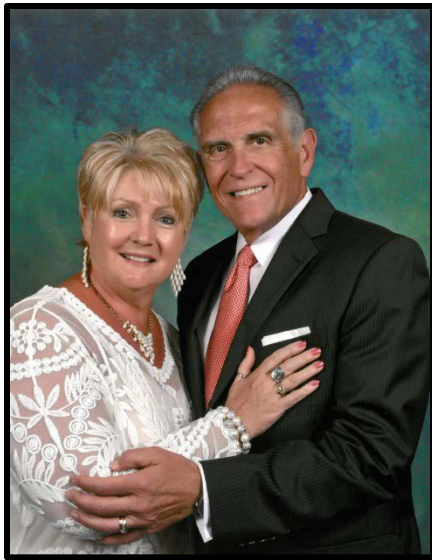

## 2016 SECRETARY'S ANNUAL REPORT

For the year 2016 this report consists of information provided in a preliminary report submitted by the General Council to my office as of April 3, 2017. The preliminary statistical report is compiled through the General Council All Church Ministry Reports for 2016. Our statistics are only as good as the information provided by our churches.

- We ended the year with 1500 ministers, an increase of fifty-nine ministers over the past year. *(A breakdown is on the tables that follow.)*
- We had an increase in the total number of churches from 350 to 369. *(A breakdown is on the following pages.)*
- Sunday A.M. attendance is currently reported at 99,814.
- Total adherents are recorded at 177,375.
- 263 churches reported conversions of 28,981, down from 2015 by 5,304.
- 230 churches reported baptisms in the Holy Spirit of 4,461, up from 2015 by 256.
- 245 churches reported water baptisms of 6,981, down 432 from 2015.

Also, included in this report are the items referred to in the Christian Education Portfolio, such as BGMC Supporting Churches, Churches Contributing to Christian Education Tithe/*I Believe in CE*, PF Kids, District School of Ministry, and the League of Christian Schools (International and Florida League of Christian Schools).



We currently have approximately 123 students divided amongst our four campuses. ## LEAGUE OF CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS

Florida League of Christian Schools and International League of Christian Schools

In 2016 the League of Christian Schools (LCS) was actively involved in the legislative processes in Florida, Virginia, and Georgia. We are happy to report we were *successful on all fronts to present and preserve the rights for Christian education*. We have become a significant voice in the Florida legislature now that FLOCS represents nearly ½ of ALL Religious Exempt preschool programs in the state of Florida.

In March 2016, we hosted the LCS Festival for Academics and the Arts at Southeastern University. We had a record number of entries over the previous year: 1,690 students, a 19% increase in participation making the LCS Festival one of the largest Fine Arts programs in the nation. We were also thrilled to have 8 NEW SCHOOLS participating in the event! The Festival features student-level (grades 3 -12) competition for academics and fine arts to help students discover and refine their God given talents and abilities.

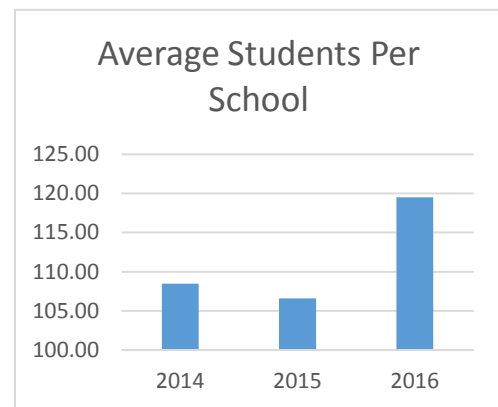
In April, ILCS participated in the Virginia Council for Private Education's meeting concerning Transgendered Identity and the impact this new trend is having on education. We continue to offer vetted policies to our member schools to help inform policy and procedures to protect them against potential backlash and litigation. With the help of our legal counsel, we have formed dozens of sample policies for schools to use as "drop in" resources.

Last year we also saw growth in our online training programs. We now offer six online programs for staff and administrators.

**Schools are Growing:** Based upon our enrollment numbers, the majority of our schools are showing increases over prior year's student enrollments. The chart shows the average student enrolment per school that reported enrollments for years 2014 – 2016.

In August we had the opportunity to discuss a potential partnership with AG World Missions. Chad Phillips oversees the academic programs of missionary students while those children are in the field with their parents.

The need for AGWM to develop its own online school for missionary kids has become a key point in the current administration. Since ILCS actually has an online school as well as robust student management systems in operation, AGWM is exploring to what capacity our association may be able to provide the infrastructure to serve missionary students while abroad. This infrastructure would include accreditation as well as the processing of transcripts through nationally recognized accreditation protocols, allowing missionary students returning to the States to transfer to the college or university of their choice.



In November 2016, the League hosted the National Christian Educators Conference in Daytona Beach, Florida. We were challenged and inspired by our keynote speaker, Michelle Tepper. We hosted just under 1,200 this year which is off from last year by just over 50 attendees.


