DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

2025 is our 100th Anniversary as a District. Even though this is the report on 2024, I want to celebrate the milestone of a century of ministry, missions, and faithful work by our leaders and lay people. Our theme for last year, this Anniversary year, and next year is LEGACY.

I was privileged to travel to Abaco, Bahamas, in January to help continue the work of restoration from the destruction of Hurricane Dorian. You gave generously to rebuild several AG church buildings on that island. It has been an extended struggle, but victory is finally within reach.

Our Sectional Council tour started in late February and continued through the first two weeks of March. I love going to each area of Peninsular Florida, fellowshipping with you, and accomplishing the business of our district. Our Ministers and delegates elected three new Presbyters: Eugene Smith in Section 6, Holly Russo in Section 13, and Grant Foster in Section 15. Just before District Council I participated with Pastor Eugene Smith and the congregation of City Church in the farewell service for our Under 40 Presbyter. Dr. Glen and Natalie Wolf accepted the pastorate of Griffin First Assembly in the Atlanta area. Then, on August 11, I assisted in their installation at GFA. They will be missed. I also installed Tim and Sissy Hass as the Senior Pastor of Gateway Church in Tampa.



We introduced a new schedule at last year's District Council. The two-day program was accepted well, saving a day and still doing all the business needed. In the business session we elected a new Presbyter to represent our Credentialed Females, Shay Cole, and a new Under 40 Presbyter, Josh Johns. Dr. Wayne Blackburn was returned to office as Executive Treasurer.

I am always honored and grateful when our pastors invite me to preach in their pulpits. I was in 27 churches, the Sectional Council tour, and Southeastern University. I helped Pastor Jeff and Angie Jennings burn their mortgage in Florida City. And it was a joy to help Fred and Barbara McDaniel celebrate their 70th Wedding Anniversary. Not all ministries are joyful, but all are important. I ministered at the funerals of Tom Peters, David Matthews, Michelle Faughnan, Charles Spong, Pat Clements, David Lee, and Evelyn Blount in 2024. Their legacy will never be forgotten. Our prayers are with the families.

Outside the district I attended or ministered in the annual AG Leadership Retreat in Branson; did two missions conventions; attended the Church Extension Plan Board meeting in Salem, Oregon; the National Black Fellowship meeting in Atlanta, and the Southeast Regional Chi Alpha conference in Knoxville, Tennessee. It was a joy to join the celebration of the 94th anniversary of Mount Zion in Plant City and rejoice with Mark and Lori Canfield on their 30th anniversary at Pinellas Community Church in St. Petersburg.



Assistant Superintendent Scott Young heads up PFMissions and has a strong connection and commitment to the AG Church Ministries Network. His election by the General Presbytery to become our new Non-Resident Southeast Region Executive Presbyter speaks of his outstanding work. We congratulate him and celebrate his election!

Dr. Tom Manning reports our district total World Missions giving for 2024 to be \$16,898,340.

Todd Weston led Light For The Lost giving to reach \$1,201,270. Number One in the nation.

District Commander Doug Moon continues to provide effective leadership for Peninsular Florida Rangers and produces one of the largest Pow Wows in the AG.

Dr. Deanna Shrodes sustains the legacy of the outstanding Women's Ministry in our district. In 2024 our ladies gave \$119,189 to missions, second most in the General Council.

Peninsular Florida never forgets its girls! District Director Bonnie Pait works tirelessly to lead Girls Ministries. Powette is tops in the nation.

PFDC Youth Camps have expanded by an additional week and are still overbooked. Plus, our young people gave more than \$371,418 to Speed the Light and another \$107,699 to support Youth Alive. Total youth missions giving was \$479,117.

Sydney Morrow leads our Children's Ministries while Executive Secretary Steve Powell provides administrative oversight. Sydney leads Kids Camp at Masterpiece and BGMC giving of \$760,000, the second highest total in our Fellowship.

Pastor Michael Nelson continues to lead our Peninsular Florida Black Fellowship with excellence. US Missionary, George Rafidi, leads the Peninsular Florida Arab Outreach.

Ken Pippin leads Finish Strong, our ministry to senior adults. He and Susan travel constantly ministering to those who have established our Legacy.

In Men's Ministries, John Hensel attracted over 600 men and boys to MoMEntum and added a disaster relief ministry to PFMen. US Missionary Jason Libby teamed up with John to make the new relief effort work.

Speaking of hurricanes, both Helene and Milton impacted Tampa Bay. Our office was totally inundated by water from Milton on October 9 and 10. We have had to repair and renovate the entire interior of our building. Total costs will be more than one million dollars.

This is a perfect place to salute and commend our district leadership team and staff. When it became obvious we would have to find temporary facilities, Southeastern generously offered accommodation in their downtown Lakeland property. Our team has kept a good attitude and worked hard. Finally, a special thanks to President Dr. Kent Ingle and Southeastern University. Without their tremendous act of kindness, we would have had no place to land. Thank you, SEU. We were homeless and you took us in.

I applaud our Presbyters and Executives for standing strong since October 10, 2024. I could not have kept us going if my excellent Executive Administrative Assistant, Tammy Stanley, had not kept me going. Our team: Steve Powell and Yohanna Irizarry along with Julianne Rosekelly and Sammy McDaniel; Wayne Blackburn, Greg Rodden and Lucy Clark and Lisa Morales, Dr. Deanna Shrodes and Judi Cotignola, Joe Barnoske, and Dr. Michael Burroughs are all champions for the Lord and our district; true professionals and faithful.

Despite the storms and challenges, the Legacy that is Peninsular Florida goes on.

Florida's population continues to grow, with an estimated increase of 467,347 people in 2024, bringing the total to 23,372,215 as of July 1, 2024. This rapid growth presents both a challenge and an opportunity—the need for new churches is more significant than ever.

Our General Superintendent and District Superintendent have a strong desire to see the same church-planting passion that ignited this district a century ago continue to burn bright. Look around you! Vast fields of human souls are ripening all around us, and are ready NOW for reaping

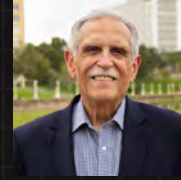

It is an honor to serve as District Secretary, and I appreciate your love and support. It has been a privilege to work alongside Superintendent Terry Raburn, Assistant Superintendent Scott Young, Treasurer M. Wayne Blackburn, and the Presbytery Board.

I want to express my gratitude to the Secretariat team in our office. We are fortunate to have Executive Administrative Assistant Yohanna Irizarry, Credentials Administrator Natalee Smith, and Sam McDaniel. Additionally, Julianne Rosekelly serves as the Administrator of the Christian Education Department, and my wife, Kathy Powell, has volunteered with us for many years. Our team includes PF Kids Director Sydney Morrow, Executive Director Dr. Michael Burroughs of the League of Christian Schools, and Administrative Assistants Dr. Tobi Manke and Ruth Severns from LCS. These individuals serve our churches, ministers, and schools with honor and excellence, and I am truly grateful for their unwavering dedication.

As of the end of 2024, we had 1606 ministers, an increase of 48 in 2024. We closed out 2024 with a total of 353 churches, which includes 52 District Affiliated, 252 General Council Affiliated, and 49 Parent Affiliated Churches (PACs). Among these churches, 271 reported a total of 34,997 conversions, 241 reported 10,196 water baptisms, and 209 reported 5,850 baptisms in the Holy Spirit. Additionally, the Peninsular Florida District reported 100,880 Sunday morning attendees. The annual report also includes data on BGMC Supporting Churches, churches contributing to the Christian Education Tithe, Pen Florida Kids, and the League of Christian Schools (*International and Florida League of Christian Schools*).

Thank you once again for the opportunity to serve you, and I look forward to continuing our work together.

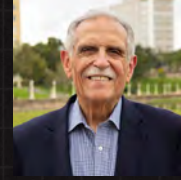

This past year for PF KIDS was special! We are so thankful for the incredible Kids Ministry leaders and Pastors that we have in Peninsular Florida that continue to keep the main thing the main thing and that is reaching kids for Jesus and being disciple makers for this Next Generation, helping them to make a difference in their world.

FUN ARTS FESTIVAL:

This past year we had our District Fun Arts Festival at Calvary Ormond Beach. It is so exciting as we see churches across our district understand their role to help kids Discover, Develop and Deploy their God-given gifts and talents. The kids in Pen-Florida are being discipled to understand that they have a role in reaching people for Jesus, and we have such an incredible opportunity with Fun Arts to help them develop their gifts to use in service to Him. We had about 25 churches take part with over 300 kids in attendance and many non-participants and parents that came to cheer on and support these amazing kids. The staff and leadership at Calvary Ormond have been such a blessing to work and serve alongside. They have been so gracious to us, and we are so thankful for Apostle Jim Raley and the Calvary staff for going above and beyond to host this incredible event. Our heart for Fun Arts is that every church would understand that we must reach this next generation and that there should be a synergy between Fun Arts and Fine Arts, because it is important to raise up this next generation with an understanding of the gifts that God has given them and help them develop those gifts and actively use them in service to the Lord. ORGANIZATIONAL GROWTH AND INNOVATION

Last year marked significant changes as LCS expanded while maintaining its focus on missionary-established schools and AG World Fellowship institutions. To meet growing needs, LCS transitioned to a new online data system, enhancing professional development tracking, resource access, and online learning.

In January, LCS attended the Accreditation Summit in Orlando, Florida, where it was recognized as the third-largest accreditor in the U.S. A new free online training program was also introduced to mentor pastors in opening Christian schools.

LCS leadership met with the Superintendent of the Tanzania Assemblies of God to plan joint training in Morogoro, Tanzania. LCS and Trinity Christian School of Sharpsburg, GA, hosted the second annual Christian Educators Conference, which saw a 25% increase in attendance. The event continues to grow, and LCS remains committed to its success.

EVENTS

In March, LCS hosted the LCS Festival at Southeastern University, with a 40% increase in participation. In July, LCS participated in the Church of God General Assembly in Indianapolis, leading to the addition of Illinois as a new operational state. LCS also hosted accreditation training and the Florida DOE-approved Professional Education Competency Course.



MINISTRY EXPANSION AND ACCREDITATION

LCS completed 30 accreditation visits, thanks to the efforts of Dr. Tobi Kent-Manke, the Accreditation Commission, and a team of trained volunteers. LCS continued its long-standing partnership with Teen Challenge, providing accreditation for six academic programs. Accreditation efforts also expanded in the U.S., including a new school in Kansas City, MO, and TCK International Academy in Springfield, MO, which supports AG World Missionaries' children.

Additionally, LCS visited Spain and the Canary Islands to assist local pastors in launching Christian schools, leading to a new PreK–Kindergarten program which officially opened last fall in Madrid.

NEW BENEFITS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

To address rising healthcare costs, LCS partnered with Higgenbotham Insurance to develop a cooperative program for more affordable staff health insurance. This is a developing program and continues to grow. Legal, business, and professional support continued, with Attorney John Cooley providing guidance to member schools.

We, at Men's Ministries and Disaster Response, are pleased to present this end of the year report. 2024 was a year of great challenges and as this wonderful Men's Ministries team rose to meet those challenges, through the help of the Lord, we (as you will discover in this report) were met with even greater blessings and victories. It is our hope that this report will both encourage those supporting ministry to men and inspire those who have yet to join this incredible team.



Virgin Islands Endurance Leadership Conference:

Due to the stoppage of transportation between the British and U.S. Virgin Islands, as a result of Hurricane Tammy in October 2023, the Conference had to be postponed and was rescheduled for April 2024. We were excited to return to the Virgin Islands for the Endurance Leadership Conference. This year's Conference offered a time of connection, encouragement, inspiration, and training. Friday Night of the Conference, the Virgin Island Pastors met together with the District Team for a time of fellowship. In 2024 Peninsular Florida Light for the Lost celebrated its fourth consecutive million-dollar-plus year in giving, leading the nation for the sixth year in a row. While we have Assemblies of God missionaries serving in over 150 countries of the world, Light for the Lost is currently active in over 250 through print, video, audio, internet technologies and apps. Through the wonder of technology, LFTL is able to take the gospel to places our missionaries are not able to go.

In the last ten years the Peninsular Florida District has given over \$9,000,000 to Light for the Lost. Included in that number is \$1,190,893.10 in cash giving in 2024. Along with providing evangelistic resources for AGWM & AGUSM missionaries, Pen Florida LFTL made large investments in 2024 in several ministry partners including Project Rescue, Teen Challenge, Youth Alive, Chi Alpha, Global University, Oral Learners, Convoy of Hope, Acts 2 Journey, and the FireBible.



In 2024 we had the privilege of taking several Pen Florida pastors on two Pastor Vision Trips to Kazakstan.

Kazakhstan is the epicenter of the Silk Road Initiative; an ambitious FireBible project that has targeted some 30 nations along the ancient Silk Road trade route. Included in this area are an estimated one thousand unreached people groups. In light of this need, the goals of the Silk Road Initiative are 10 new FireBible translations to be launched in 10 years, reaching a potential audience of over 300 million people.

All that Pen Florida LFTL has accomplished is made possible through the generous giving of our churches and constituents. I would like to thank the 152 Pen Florida Churches that supported LFTL in 2024. The number of participating churches is up nearly 5 percentage points (43.06%) from previous years. Our goal in 2025 is to reach 50% of Pen Florida participating churches with a total of \$1.5 million in LFTL giving.

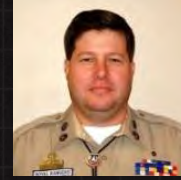

The year of 2024 came and went by very fast, as they all seem to do anymore. While we were able to find success in reaching many boys for the Lord, we were challenged once again. It's hard to find replacements for the those leaders that were lost. While we did gain some new leaders in churches around the District, we are struggling to find more help that is willing to do things outside of the church. I joke with our staff that the average age in the room continues to get older each year as we are having a harder time getting younger men to be committed to help at the Sectional or District level. Please keep this in prayer for us as we are moving forward. We need younger men to be able to minister to the boys and younger men that we are trying to reach. The younger generation certainly needs positive role models that they can follow.

We were however, pretty successful in the events we held last year. The first event we held last year was our annual Trace and Adventure for FCF. This year we did a joint event with the FMD District at our camp. We invited them to join us and were glad they were able to attend. It allowed both groups to spend time with people they wouldn't normally be able to. I think it was a good opportunity for all to create new friendships and form relationships with others that are involved in the same ministry. We had over 100 in attendance and increased the number of those participating from our District from last year. We also had almost 30 people join FCF at this event. This is the most we've had in the last 10 years. It's good to have our numbers for attendance go up again for this event. We had great services and many competitive events that all enjoyed. It was a great way to kick off as we started the new year.

We only had one District Royal Ranger event in the next couple of months. That was our District Pow Wow. This is historically the biggest event we have each year. This year our number was up slightly again. We had just over 1300 in attendance. While that's not a huge increase, we are happy that we are continuing to gain in attendance. Everyone that attended had a great time and the event went really well. We ran three services at consecutive times each night so all the boys could be ministered to on their own level. We had boys saved at each of the services both nights. That's the only reason we put all the effort into our events and as usual God came through as only He can.

In May we hosted a National Leaders Training event at our camp. We had 71 leaders sign up to come. It was the largest the National Office has had in a while and they were surprised we had so many people attend. This is a great number because last year they had to cancel the same event because we couldn't get enough people to register to have the event. The minimum number is 24 and we couldn't get that many people to sign up last year, so you can see that we have created some good momentum over the last year to have as good of a turnout out this year as we did.

In the first 6 months of last year we also had 4 churches contact us about starting Rangers for the first time in their church or reforming an outpost they had many years ago. This is another great sign that we do have some positive momentum going right now. Please pray with us that we can continue to have more success and as a result the ability to reach more people for Jesus.

In the summer we had our SMC (Skills Merit Camp) and our JTC (Junior Missions Camp). The Merit Camp had around 40 kids in attendance. The boys each earned 6 merits while they were there. It's a fun filled, action packed camp that keeps the kids going all day for four days. At the Missions Camp the kids learn the value of helping serve others and help with various projects at the camp or in nearby towns depending on the year and what projects are available.



During the fall we had a couple of leadership training events across the District. These are hosted in the local sections or divisions. We also had multiple Sectional Round Ups, these are held on the sectional and divisional level across the District.

The only other event we had on a District level was our Junior Training Camps in December. We had three different camps simultaneously and had about 20 boys attend. The boys learn leadership skills while attending various camps and outdoor activities.



We also had groups come out to the camp and do work to help clean up from the hurricanes. We have a couple of workdays days scheduled for the first part of 2025 as well. There is still lots of work that needs to be done to clean up damage to the trees at the camp. Fortunately, we got no damage to any structures from the storms.

The numbers were up slightly through most of our events last year again this year. Thank you for your support as we try to reach as many boys and young men for the Lord as we can.

The mission of PF Women is to help women of every generation thrive and reach their full potential through the power of the Holy Spirit. Our vision is to create a movement of women that will change the world through the innovative power of the Holy Spirit.

We began our year with the news that once again, PF Women is among the top missions giving districts in the Assemblies of God. In 2024, Pen Florida women took second place nationwide for Touch the World and Light the Way giving. We are so grateful to everyone who made missions giving a priority last year. In addition to supporting many of our Pen Florida missionaries with funds for household goods, it was our joy to give to many other mission projects. The special projects we supported this year included: Inspire Global Sisterhood, Thailand Project/Wayne and Tammy Brown, The Table Church Plant/Home Missions Project, Living Revelations Ministry, Chaplain Teresa Rolls-Wilcox, Colombia Project/Jimmy & Jill Susa, Dan and Paula Lumadue, Project Rescue, U.S. Youth Alive/Natalie Barnoske, U.S. Single Moms/Lois Breit, Empowered Master's Commission Women's Edition, Women's Teen Challenge Jacksonville, and The Cloud Project/Thailand. We also gave a special offering to all our Pen Florida single female missionaries to help them reach the goals of their mission field.



PF Women headed to Thailand in 2024, taking a team of women from across the district, bringing hope to this challenging mission field where very few know Christ. Our women provided everything for a conference, the theme of which was BLOOM -- done with excellence, for the women of Bangkok. During our time there we did many outreaches to local schools and ministered in several church services. Our host missionary, Tammy Brown, said that in all of her years on the field in Thailand, our time with them was one of the greatest moves of God they have ever seen. It was one of the best trips in PF Women history, and we can't wait to do it again!

The leadership arm of PF Women is the Stronger Leadership Network, and the 2024 Stronger Conference was one of the most successful yet. Women were trained, equipped and encouraged on every level. The event was held at Arise Church in Brandon, Florida. Our key speakers were Rev. Lisa Potter, Pastor Tina Blount, and me. The general sessions, practical leadership tools and networking opportunities were of tremendous value to the hundreds of female ministers, spouses of ministers, women's ministry directors, businesswomen, and up-and-coming leaders. We are grateful for the generosity of Pastors Brent and Ada Simpson and the Arise team, for hosting us.

The 2024 year was the fourth year for the Stronger Leadership Cohort, a smaller group of female leaders who are ready to go to the next level in their leadership journey. Last year we had 46 women who were a part of it. Each meeting of the cohort featured national and internationally known leaders who invested in women's lives. Any female leader in the district can apply to be a part of the cohort. There are many female ministers, credentialed women, pastors' wives, and marketplace leaders in the group.

Throughout the year we continued to produce the weekly Stronger Leadership Podcast which helps leaders become even stronger for the glory of God and the good of people they serve. Podcast episodes drop each Wednesday. Although we intended the podcast to be a tool to help build,



equip and motivate Pen Florida leaders, we are astounded and humbled at the extent of our listening audience that now spans not only Pen Florida but all of the United States and 26 other countries.

PF Women hosted a 5 x 7 leadership luncheon at District Council and hundreds of district leaders were present. Five speakers shared for seven minutes each on relevant leadership topics. Those who shared were Malcolm Burleigh, Natalie Kahler, Trent Morgan, Macy Pickerall and Gabrielle Santiago. Additionally, the event gave us a few moments to share with our ministers about ways PF Women can help them, and the local church. All year long we have people thank us for hosting this luncheon and the impact it makes on their lives.



During the month of May we hit the road, taking the ABUNDANCE TOUR all over the district. Women from coast-to-coast experienced breakthroughs and lives were changed forever. The summer tour is now our largest attended event, with well over 2,000 women attending one of the tour stops.

THRIVE 2024 exceeded expectations as the altars were filled with women hungry for God, receiving salvation, the baptism in the Holy Spirit and miracle healings. Women of all generations and backgrounds joined together for this life-changing weekend. The 2024 conference theme was WORLD CHANGER and featured keynote speakers Beth Stephens, Judi Cotignola, Erika Hendricks and me.

I am so thankful for our outstanding team. One of our core values at PF Women is that we are an oasis of excellence, and our team members make this a reality! We could not accomplish what we do without an army of volunteers year-round, not just during event season. We were excited to have our second-largest year of PFY Fine Arts, even in a year when Nationals was not in Orlando! From the FAF team to the amazing Youth Pastors and students of Pen Florida, we are speechless. The numbers are as follows: 1,614 students participated, with 3,841 individual registrations and 1,680 presentations. This year was exceptional. So many people expressed how smooth the event was. We are truly blessed to work with an exceptional team. Additionally, there were over 400 presentations at the national festival. We received 22 Merit Awards for 7 different churches. We also had 177 Top 10 finishes.



YOUTH CAMP – We Believe in Seeking God's Presence

What an incredible summer! With the addition of a 6th week of Youth Camp, our numerical growth is indicative that our district is experiencing a powerful move of God. We finished the summer with 2,829 in attendance. This is an increase of 451 people, including 253 who stayed in hotels. The spiritual impact has increased significantly. First-time Salvations - 151, Rededications - 738, Filled with the Holy Spirit - 1,360, Healings - 639, and Called into Ministry - 392. All the worship teams and speakers opened Heaven in our services. Morning services empowered students, and our games have gone to another level. To provide more water activities, we rented a massive 40 ft slide and a 95 ft obstacle course. The new laser tag system was amazing. In 2025, we will have our new 600 ft Zipline.

FLORIDA MISSIONS

Miami Missions was a success this year. Amanda Hahn, David Houck, and Robbie Morrow helped us host an incredible trip. We reached two communities again this year. Outreaches included feeding the homeless, serving

in bilingual services, hosting block parties every night, and service projects in several areas of the city of Miami. Pastor Robbie Morrow is helping us build a stronger local involvement.

SECTIONAL LEADER GETAWAY

As a leadership team, we all came together in Orlando where we provided a night in the hotel, tickets to Cirque du Soleil, and a fun dinner together. On Friday, we spent time in prayer, the Word, and presented vision for the future of PFYouth. It was a blessing to come together with our sectional leaders and staff; 51 leaders attended the weekend.

JESUS TOUR & STL GIVING – We Believe That Giving Is Our Privilege

Six regions hosted the Jesus Tour. The main goal was to have a fun event for students that promoted Giving and Going. Missionaries challenged us to share the love of Jesus locally and globally. Our total attendance was 1,055 people. We are proud of our sectional leaders for taking the lead in their regions.

Speed the Light and Missionary Support!

For the first time, we hosted the Youth Missions Gala on the Thursday prior to the Youth Leaders and Creative Conference. The celebration included the presentation of our student’s giving, a few special projects, and the need for all the missionary vehicles.

Youth Missions supported efforts in Zambia, India, Malawi, Belgium, Gambia, Nepal, Japan, Russia, Eurasia, and the United States. We gave towards human trafficking, disaster relief, child adoption, drug addiction, business-as-mission, a water trailer for West Texas youth camp, and missionary monthly support and vehicles. We also empowered thousands of students to reach the lost and hurting at their schools. We are bringing the Gospel to the nations and passing the baton to the next generation! Our total Youth Missions giving was \$479,117.29, which included the Speed the Light giving of \$371,418.47. Speed the Light is the only effort providing vehicles for ALL our missionaries! Thank you for your generous giving! The total giving list is included.

2024 SOUTHEASTERN UNIVERSITY ANNUAL PRESIDENT'S REPORT TO THE DISTRICTS

As president of Southeastern University (SEU), I am thrilled to share with our supporting districts some of the incredible highlights from this past year and a glimpse into the exciting future God has in store for us.

Since our founding in 1935, SEU has been committed to providing a premier Christian education while partnering with the local church. Together, we will continue to rise to meet the needs of a changing world while staying grounded in the biblical truths that have always defined us as a university.

ENROLLMENT, MINISTRY TRAINING, AND ACADEMICS

Enrollment: As of Fall 2024, SEU has a total enrollment of 11,763 students, which includes our Lakeland campus, partner sites, online, and dual enrollment. There are also 308 international students from 56 countries. SEU has also upheld its ranking as the second fastest-growing private, non-profit, doctoral-level institution in the nation as reported by The Chronicle of Higher Education.

Top Producer of Ministry Graduates: SEU ranked **third in the nation** in Colleges with the Most Bachelor's Degrees Conferred by Discipline in the Theology and Religious Vocations category (source: The Chronicle of Higher Education).

SEU Ministry Network: Over **3,500 students** are currently studying at one of our **200+ partner sites** nationwide.

Students Preparing for Ministry: As of Fall 2024, SEU has graduated a total of **8,318 ministry degree graduates** since 1935. In 2023-24, the Barnett College of Ministry & Theology had the **highest number of graduates** (462) out of all of the colleges and departments at SEU. This year alone, **over 1,900 students are currently enrolled in ministry programs and training for ministry-related vocations.**

Life Skills House: This past fall, a brand new space on campus known as the Life Skills House opened for students from SEU's Pathways School of Excellence to use for the **practice of essential independent living skills.** The Pathways School of Excellence is a program for students ages 11 to 22 with special needs. The Life Skills House is structured and equipped for the development of skills related to cooking, cleaning, laundry, exercise, and more..

Supporting Ministry Students: Through the late Robert and Sandra Graper, the Graper Family Scholarship Endowment of **\$4.1 million** was recently established at SEU to **provide scholarships for students pursuing degrees in ministry.** The endowment will provide five scholarships of \$10,000 annually.

SEU Choral Students' Carnegie Hall Performance: In April of 2024, **45 students** from SEU's choral program had the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to perform at Carnegie Hall in New York City. They were conducted by Dr. Daniel Gordon of the SEU School of Music and joined by five SEU alumni.



ALUMNI HIGHLIGHTS



Alumni Milestone: We are proud to announce that SEU's alumni community has now **surpassed our 25,000 milestone.** This record-breaking achievement reflects the incredible growth of our SEU family and the lasting impacts our graduates are making around the world.

Rachael Groll, Class of 2018: SEU alumna Rachael Groll is an author and creator of the popular Christian podcast, Hearing Jesus, which has neared **7 million downloads** and has been in the **top 20 charts for Christian podcasts.** Her podcast has also made the top 20 for religion and spirituality podcasts and the **top .5% globally in all podcasts.**

Riley Minix, Class of 2023: Former Fire men's basketball player Riley Minix was drafted as a free agent to the **San Antonio Spurs** and had the opportunity to take part in the **NBA's Summer League.** He averaged 12 points per game on 44.8% shooting and 50% shooting from three.

STUDENTS SERVING

Student Philanthropy: SEU students have made an incredible difference this year, rallying together to support amazing causes both near and far. Together, our student body has **raised more than \$18,000** for needs including local hurricane relief and support for Californians after the wildfires this spring. More than **475 students served** our local community with a total of over **1,900 volunteer hours** through Love Lakeland, and **250+ students** gathered to pack more than **2,500 grocery bags** with Convoy of Hope to fight hunger.

SEU Missions: This year, we are sending out a total of **600 students on 38 trips**. Over the spring break, 200 students were sent on nine trips to **South Africa, Norway, Ireland, Miami, Jamaica, Costa Rica, Cuba, Mexico, and the Middle East**. These students partnered with organizations such as Impact Africa, YWAM Nordland, Living & Learning International, and Glad Tidings. During their trips, they witnessed people hearing the Gospel for the first time, healings, miracles, and **lives forever changed**.



ATHLETIC NEWS

SEU earned **The Sun Conference Commissioner's Cup** for the 2023-24 season, honoring SEU as **the top-achieving institution in the conference**. This was the fourth time that the university has earned The Cup in the last five years.

SEU placed **13th in the NAIA Learfield Directors' Cup** for the 2023-24 season. All eight spring sports **advanced and participated in their NAIA national championships**, as well as women's soccer, women's cross country, wrestling, and women's basketball.

In men's track, Fire athlete James Williamson III was named the **NAIA National Championship Most Outstanding Performer** after winning the 200 meter, then running the opening leg on the **National Championship 4 x 100 relay team**.

The Fire baseball team finished their season at the **NAIA World Series** for the sixth consecutive year after achieving an overall record of 52-8 overall and a 22-2 Sun Conference record. The team also earned their sixth **Sun Conference Tournament Championship title** after going 4-0 in the tournament.

Women's basketball **claimed both the regular season and The Sun Conference tournament titles**, and advanced to the **NAIA National Tournament**, with a 22-8 record.

In the 2024-25 season, Fire athlete Gage Braun took home the 285-pound **NAIA Wrestling National Championship**, becoming the first Fire wrestler to win **two national titles** in program history. As a team, Fire wrestling came in third place at the national championships.
